John Heath was born on the 25<sup>th</sup> June 1783 and baptised on the 20 July 1783 Horton. Died on the 8<sup>th</sup> September 1862 late of Lane End Farm Endon. Will proved at Lichfield by George Heath farmer and John Heath farmer and son both of Endon executors. Effects under £300.

A former member of the 1835 Endon Chapel. His obituary in the Leek Wesleyan Year Book states that he was 'A consistent and local preacher for forty years. Supported men and women of devotion and purpose. The Chapel prospered for forty years.

John married Hannah Pickford on the 24<sup>th</sup> November 1806 t Leek St Edward.

Hannah was baptised on the 8<sup>th</sup> May 1785 the daughter of Moses Pickford and Joice Reade. Hannah died on the 26<sup>th</sup> January, and was buried on the 28<sup>th</sup> January 1826 at Horton.
