PRISONER FOUND INSANE.
George Wood (55), labourer, was inducted for
the attempted murder of Annie Wood, at Sta-
dulpa, on August 1st.—Mr. R. J. Lawrence, who
had been instructed to prosecute, said a question
would arise as to whether the prisoner was,
owing to the state of his mind, fit to plead.—
Dr. Watson, medical officer of the prison, was
called, and he stated that he had had the pri-
soner under observation for some months, and
he did not think that the prisoner was of suffi-
cient intellect to comprehend the proceedings,
to plead, or to understand the evidence.—The
jury, by direction of the judge, returned a ver-
dict that the prisoner was insane, and he was
ordered to be detained during his Majesty's
pleasure
