George Heath the son of John Heath and Sarah was baptised on the 12th February 1801 at Horton. George of Horton parish a farmer married Martha Mayer (The daughter of George Mayer and Sarah Pickford was baptised on the 20th April 1806 at Endon St Luke. Martha died on the 10th February 1889 late of Endon. Will proved by Edward Withinshaw Hollinshead of Tunstall, was buried on the 14th February at Endon) on the 29th December 1825 at Leek St Edward. George died on the 30th October 1878 late of Endon. The will was proved at the Principal Registry Office by Thomas Heath Farmer and Richard Heath Land Surveyor and Robert Cleminson Land Surveyor all of Endon.

Mary Heath the daughter of George Heath and Martha Mayer. Mary married Robert Cleminson a land surveyor on the 24th July 1849 at Leek St Edward. Mary was buried on the 8th February 1898 at Endon St Luke. Leek Post dated the 12th February 1898. Death of Mrs Cleminson - the death of this lady at her residence (Springfield House), early on Sunday morning after a brief illness came as a painful shock to the inhabitants of Endon, by whom she was universally loved and respected. The whole of her life had been spent in her native village, where her father (Mr George Heath) and afterwards her husband the late Mr Robert Cleminson were the chief and most influential supporters of the Wesleyan body. For her constant and unostentatious deeds of charity, her quick and ready sympathy extended towards the sufferings of others irrespective of class or creed, and the example of a Christian life, the influence of which was known and felt by those around her. The memory of the deceased lady will long be cherished by all who had been in contact with her.

Daughter Martha Elizabeth Cleminson born 1853 Leek Martha Elizabeth married Edward Withinshaw Hollinshead a solicitor (died on the 8th March 1916 of Endon. Edward left £20019 8s 1d) on the 13th September 1876 at Endon. Martha Elizabeth died on the 14th January 1929 at Endon, leaving £11259 9s 3d.

1911 census shows that Edward, his wife Martha and son Robert Edward aged 21 are living in a nine roomed house at Endon, employing a cook and house maid.

George Heath the son of George Heath and Martha Mayer was born on 16th September 1829 at Endon and was baptised on the 11th October 1829 at Leek Wesleyan Mount Pleasant. George married Ann Rebecca Hartley (buried on the 30th July 1864 at Endon) on the 1st January 1857 at Leek St Edward.

Emily Gertrude Heath the daughter of Ernest Heath and Ella Heath Forester was baptised on the 12th December 1885 Whitmore. Emily Gertrude married William Eason Tonkinson in 1906 at Stoke St Peter. On the 14th of May 1919 Emily was living 16 Webster Street Newcastle-under-Lyme.

Annie Heath the daughter of Ernest Heath and Ella Heath Forester was born in 1888 Swynnerton Annie married Joseph Guy in 1906 at Stoke St Peter. On the 14th May 1919 Annie was living at 3 Market Place Stoke-on-Trent.

Robert Hartley Heath the son of Ernest Heath and Ella Heath Forester was born 1890 in Swynnerton. Robert Hartley married Gertrude A Wainwright in 1915 at Newcastle-under-Lyme Civil Marriage. Children Walter Hartley Heath born before marriage was born on the 15th September 1914 at Stoke-on-Trent married Frances Marjorie Grocott Trent Vale Roman Catholic Church. On the 14th May 1919 Robert was living at 27 Upper Cliff Bank Stoke-on-Trent. Daughter Alice May born on the 17th October 1919 Stoke-on-Trent, and 2nd son Robert William Heath born on the 19th October 1920 Newcastle-under-Lyme.

Mary Elizabeth Heath the daughter of Enoch Heath and Ella Forester was born in 1898 at Newcastle-under-Lyme. Mary married John E Woods in 1916 at Newcastle-under-Lyme St Giles. On the 14th May 1919 Mary Elizabeth was living at 16 Webster Street Newcastle-under-Lyme.

George Edward Heath the son of Enoch Heath and Ella Heath was born in 1901 Stoke-on-Trent. On the 14th May 1919 George Edward is living at Garden? Penkull.

John Heath the son of George Heath and Martha Mayer was born on the 22nd September 1831 and was baptised on the 17th October 1831 at Leek Circuit Mount Pleasant Wesleyan.

Martha Heath the daughter of George Heath and Martha Mayer was born on the 7th October 1832 at Endon. Martha married George Nixon on the 14th April 1854 at Wolstanton. Martha was buried at Endon St Luke B.58 removed, In memory of Martha, wife of George Nixon late of Brindley Ford, and second daughter of George and Martha Heath, of Endon Bank, who died on the 1st May 1862, aged 29 years. Precious in the sight of the Lord is the death of his Saints.

Sarah Ann Heath the daughter of George Heath and Martha Mayer was born on the 22nd June 1834. Sarah Ann married John Forrister on the 19th April 1859 Norton lee Moors St Bartholomew. Sarah Ann Forester died on the 10th August aged 31 years, and was buried on the 14th August 1865 at Endon St Luke of Endon Bank. Headstone moved or buried due to extension, and Robert son of the above aged 21 months.

Robert Heath Forester was born in 1860 and was buried on the 1st September 1862 at Endon of Milton.

Ella Heath Forrester daughter of John Forester and Sarah Ann Heath was born on the 3rd August 1863. Ella married Ernest Heath on the 15th September 1884 at Newcastle-under-Lyme St George. See Ernest Heath for further details.

Mary Jane Heath the daughter of John Forester and Sarah Ann Heath was born on the 13th May 1865. Mary Jane Forester married Frederick Ernest Abbott on the 1st September 1886 at Endon Wesleyan Methodist.

The 1891 census sees Mary Jane and her husband Frederick a doctor general practitioner and daughter Gladys at Henry Street Carlisle.

William aged 20 of Endon Bank married Ann Bailey aged 21 (the daughter of Josiah Bailey of the Hollins in Horton Parish) on the 26th May 1857 Leek St Edward. William died on the 14th February 1889 of Rownall and buried on the 19th February 1889 at Endon.
